| <b>APPLICATION PROCESS</b>  | Applicants must apply online at <a href="http://wpcarey.asu.edu/scholarships">http://wpcarey.asu.edu/scholarships</a>  |
| <b>REQUIRED ITEMS</b>   | Must contain completed online application, completed FASFA and Additional Essay responses. Essay responses must be uploaded electronically to the online application.  |
| <b>ELIGIBILITY</b>  | Scholarship <u>criteria</u> must be met at time of application as well as during the academic year specified on application. Please note, <i>ASU-HBA</i> will review and confirm eligibility status at the time of application as well as at the end of each semester of the award year, including Spring 2017 grades. Should you meet the requirements of both scholarships criteria, your application will be considered for both. |
| <b>FAFSA</b>  | Students are required to file a Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) by the application deadline. Failure to do so will disqualify you from consideration of both scholarships.  |
| <b>IDENTIFICATION</b>   | <b>To ensure confidentiality, please DO NOT include your name in any of the essay questions.</b>   |
| <b>ACADEMIC AWARD YEAR</b>  | Fall and Spring semesters in which award is received (summer sessions will not be recognized).   |
| <b>REAPPLYING</b>   | Student must apply each year to be considered for renewal.   |
| <b>PARTICIPATION</b>  | Scholarship recipients will be <b>required</b> to attend and <b>volunteer</b> time at <i>ASU-HBA</i> fundraising events, Noche De Loteria and Sparky Classic Golf Tournament, and/or sponsored functions.  |
| <b>TIME TO COMPLETION</b>   | If FASFA and essay questions are completed, the remaining application should take approximately 10 to 15 minutes to complete.  |
| <b>ASU LATINO PARTNERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP</b>   | <i>ASU-HBA</i> partners with this community of Latino organizations to provide undergraduate students with scholarships each academic year.  |
| <b>ASU-HISPANIC BUSINESS ALUMNI ENDOWMENT</b>   | <i>ASU-HBA</i> has an endowment established to provide undergraduate students with scholarships each academic year.  |

**ASU LATINO PARTNERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP  
SELECTION CRITERIA**

Scholarship Recipients will be selected based on the following characteristics:

- Academic Achievement
- Financial Need
- Community Service
- Leadership Qualities
- Education/Career Goals
- Quality of Additional Essay Responses

**ASU LATINO PARTNERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP  
ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Admitted to Arizona State University as a full-time undergraduate business degree student enrolled at W.P. Carey School of Business.
- Cumulative GPA above 3.0
- Classified as Arizona resident for tuition purposes (residency is determined at the time of application to ASU). Arizona law requires students receiving resident tuition and/ASU institutional scholarships, including this one, to demonstrate lawful presence in the United States.
- Student must remain enrolled in ASU courses as a full-time undergraduate W.P. Carey business student with a minimum of 12 ASU credit hours each fall and spring semester in order for your scholarship to disburse. Although your scholarship will disburse at 12 ASU credit hours, ASU highly recommends you complete a minimum of 15 ASU credit hours per semester to ensure you successfully complete a total of 30 ASU credit hours by the conclusion of the spring semester to remain on track to graduate within four years. Summer session and consortium agreement courses, Advanced Placement credits, and transfer credits from other colleges/universities DO NOT satisfy full-time credit-hour requirements for renewal eligibility.
- This scholarship may not be combined with the following ASU institutional merit awards: National Scholars Award (National Merit Finalist, National Hispanic Finalist, National Achievement Finalist), President's Award, and Provost's Award. If you received the Regents High Honors Endorsement scholarship prior to the 2013- 2014 school year, your award may not be combined with this scholarship.
- The ASU Latino Partnership Scholars is comprised of the following partners: César Chávez Leadership Institute, Chicano/Latino Faculty and Staff Association, Chicanos Por La Causa, Inc., ASU Hispanic Business Alumni, Los Diablos Alumni and Hispanic Women's Corporation. ASU students are able to apply for more than one of the ASU Latino Partnership Scholars awards but can only be awarded one ASU Latino Partnership Scholars award.
- Dependents of an ASU employee or retiree who qualify for a tuition subsidy are NOT eligible.
- Selected scholars are required to complete a minimum of 40 hours of community service per academic year. Selected scholars are required to attend and volunteer at *ASU-HBA* fundraising events, Noche De Loteria and Sparky Classic Golf Tournament, and/or approved functions (selected scholars will be notified of dates and locations). "Community service hour forms must be completed, signed and submitted to the *ASU-HBA* Board Scholarship Committee Chair by the end of each semester for scholarship disbursement.
- This scholarship may be used toward educational expenses including tuition and fees, housing, books and other costs of attendance. Accepting this scholarship may result in changes to your ASU financial aid package.

- Cumulative GPA above 3.0
- Classified as Arizona resident for tuition purposes (residency is determined at the time of application to ASU). Arizona law requires students receiving resident tuition and/ASU institutional scholarships, including this one, to demonstrate lawful presence in the United States.
- Student must remain enrolled in ASU courses as a full-time undergraduate W.P. Carey business student with a minimum of 12 ASU credit hours each fall and spring semester in order for your scholarship to disburse. Although your scholarship will disburse at 12 ASU credit hours, ASU highly recommends you complete a minimum of 15 ASU credit hours per semester to ensure you successfully complete a total of 30 ASU credit hours by the conclusion of the spring semester to remain on track to graduate within four years. Summer session and consortium agreement courses, Advanced Placement credits, and transfer credits from other colleges/universities DO NOT satisfy full-time credit hour requirements for renewal eligibility.
- Must be a Sophomore, Junior or Senior status to qualify. Academic status is determined by ASU based on the number of credit hours earned.
- Selected scholars are required to attend and volunteer at *ASU-HBA* fundraising events, Noche De Loteria and Sparky Classic Golf Tournament, and/or approved functions (selected scholars will be notified of dates and locations).
- This scholarship may be used toward educational expenses including tuition and fees, housing, books and other costs of attendance. Accepting this scholarship may result in changes to your ASU financial aid package.
