AMOUNT	Varies
APPLICATION PROCESS	Applicants must apply online at http://wpcarey.asu.edu/scholarships
REQUIRED ITEMS	Must contain completed application, resume, financial data (form included), completed FASFA and personal goal statement/essay. Resume and essay responses must be uploaded electronically.
ELIGIBILITY	Scholarship <u>criteria</u> must be met at time of application as well as during the academic year specified on application. Please note, <i>ASU-HBA</i> will review and confirm eligibility status at the time of application as well as at the end of each semester of the award year, including Spring 2013 grades post. Should you meet the requirements of both scholarships criteria, your application will be considered for both.
FAFSA	Students are required to file a Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) by the application deadline. Failure to do so will disqualify you from consideration of both scholarships.
IDENTIFICATION	To ensure confidentiality, please include your full name on the initial page of the application only.
ACADEMIC AWARD YEAR	Fall and Spring semesters in which award is received (summer sessions will not be recognized).
REAPPLYING	Student must apply each year to be considered for renewal.
PARTICIPATION	Scholarship recipients will be required to attend and volunteer time at <i>ASU-HBA</i> fundraising events and/or sponsored functions.
TIME TO COMPLETION	If resume, FASFA and essay questions are completed, the remaining application should take approximately 10 to 15 minutes to complete.

# FREEPORT-MCMORAN UNA PROMESA COMMUNITY ASU-HBA SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA

- Education/Career Goals
- Quality of Personal Statement

### FREEPORT-MCMORAN UNA PROMESA COMMUNITY ASU-HBA SCHOLARSHIP ELEGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Admitted to Arizona State University as a full-time undergraduate business degree-seeking student.
- Cumulative GPA above 3.0
- Classified as Arizona resident for tuition purposes (residency is determined at the time of application to ASU). Arizona law requires students receiving resident tuition and/ASU institutional scholarships, including this one, to demonstrate lawful presence in the United States.
- Student must remain enrolled in ASU courses as a full-time undergraduate business student with a
  minimum of 12 ASU credit hours each fall and spring semester in order for your scholarship to disburse.
  Although your scholarship will disburse at 12 ASU credit hours, ASU highly recommends you complete a
  minimum of 15 ASU credit hours per semester to ensure you successfully complete a total of 30 ASU credit
  hours by the conclusion of the spring semester to remain on track to graduate within four years. Summer
  session and consortium agreement courses, Advanced Placement credits, and transfer credits from other
  colleges/universities DO NOT satisfy full-time credit-hour requirements for renewal eligibility.
- This scholarship may **NOT** be combined with the following ASU institutional awards: National Scholars Award, President's Award, Provost's Award, Obama Scholarship. In the event you become qualified for an ASU institutional award with a higher dollar value than the Freeport-McMoRan Una Promesa Community *ASU-HBA* Scholarship Award, you will keep the ASU institutional award, which will replace the Freeport-McMoRan Una Promesa Community *ASU-HBA* Scholarship Award.
- Dependents of an ASU employee or retiree who qualify for a tuition subsidy are **NOT** eligible.
- Selected scholars are <u>required</u> to complete a minimum of 40 hours of community service per academic year. A total of 20 hours of the 40 community service hours must be completed at *ASU-HBA* events or sponsored functions. Community service hour forms must be complete, signed and submitted to the *ASU-HBA* Board Scholarship Committee Chair by the end of each semester for scholarship disbursement.
- Selected scholars are <u>required</u> to attend and/or volunteer at ASU-HBA sponsored events including the following: ASU-HBA Scholar Reception & Orientation, the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Budweiser Shootout Golf Tournament and the 2014 Noche de Loteria (selected scholars will be notified of dates and locations).
- This scholarship may be used toward educational expenses including tuition and fees, housing, books and other costs of attendance. Accepting this scholarship may result in changes to your ASU financial aid package.

  minimum of 12 ASU credit hours each fall and spring semester in order for your scholarship to disburse.
  Although your scholarship will disburse at 12 ASU credit hours, ASU highly recommends you complete a
  minimum of 15 ASU credit hours per semester to ensure you successfully complete a total of 30 ASU credit
  hours by the conclusion of the spring semester to remain on track to graduate within four years. Summer
  session and consortium agreement courses, Advanced Placement credits, and transfer credits from other
  colleges/universities DO NOT satisfy full-time credit-hour requirements for renewal eligibility.
- Must be a Sophomore, Junior or Senior status to qualify. Academic status is determined by ASU based on the number of credit hours earned.
- Selected scholars are <u>required</u> to attend and/or volunteer at ASU-HBA sponsored events including the following: ASU-HBA Scholar Reception & Orientation, the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Budweiser Shootout Golf Tournament and the 2014 Noche de Loteria (selected scholars will be notified of dates and locations).
